- Testing is only offered only on the [Lee Campus](#)
- Students are permitted to attempt the HESI only twice between January-December
- There must be a 30 day waiting period between tests
- HESI exam costs \$60.00. You will need to pay for it at your campus Cashier's Office. Please include on your exam your [Edison](#) e-mail address, phone number and first and second choices on the receipt in case your first choice is full when receipt is turned in. If you do not include your [Edison](#) e-mail, you will not receive an e-mail confirmation. We will not confirm through e-mail with a personal e-mail account.
 - On Lee Campus: bring the HESI receipt to building "AA" room 167D (Michelle DeBona, Student Admission Specialist) or fax receipt to 239-489-9086 ATTN: Michelle DeBona
 - On Collier Campus: bring the HESI receipt to building "J" room 117 and they will assist you further
 - On Charlotte Campus: bring the HESI receipt to building "E" room 111 (Wendy Williams Morris, Staff Assistant) and they will further assist you
- Testing subjects include Anatomy & Physiology, Biology, and Math up to Basic Algebra, Grammar, Vocabulary, and Reading Comprehension. Chemistry and Physics are not required

- Study guide may be purchased at Edison Bookstore. Continuing Education occasionally hosts reviews (this is not done through the nursing department). Check online for their schedule at Edison State College Continuing Education
- No pen/pencil, personal calculator, cellular telephone or scratch paper allowed during testing. Calculators will be provided on the exam. Photo ID required on testing day
- Please see the HESI No-Show Policy for any questions regarding rescheduling exam or not showing for the exam
- Students may not take the HESI Exam and the Mobility Exam on the same day. They are separate exams and must be taken at separate times.
- Students who show up late for exams must notify staff. If you have not notified staff, 15 minutes after the exam starts, your seat will be given to any stand by students.
- Please be courteous to others and show up on time. When students show up late, it can be distracting to others. The exam starts promptly at 9:00a or 4:30p. You may start to arrive 30 minutes prior to exam time.
