

Timeline for Firefighter Minimum Standards February 2012

Testing:

FCELPT (CPT): minimum scores - Reading (104), Sentence Skills (99), and Math (113). Test date must be within the previous two years. **OR** TABE - Full Battery Level A: minimum score - 10. Test date must be within the previous two years.

Fill out a Fire Academy Application:

Accepted in person starting *May 23rd through December 8th 2011* - and starting again *January 3rd through January 27, 2012 Monday - Friday 9am 4pm* at Edison State College Lee Campus room B-115B and B-117. If you are unable to apply in person please call 239-489-9392 OR 239-489-9108 for other options for submitting your application.

Complete the State Form DFS-K4-1022 - Medical Examination to Determine Fitness for Firefighter Training:

Once your application has been accepted, the Medical Examination to Determine Fitness for Firefighter Training (Form DFS-K4-1022) will be sent to you. This form shall be completed after November 1st 2011 and prior to attending the first Practice Physical Ability Test.

Practice PAT (PPAT) Sessions Dates & Times (optional):

Three 2 hour sessions PPAT included in application fee. Additional practices sessions can be purchased for \$55.00 each.

The PPAT will be conducted in the evening with two sessions to choose from

Session 1: from 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm

Session 2: From 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm on the following dates:

Monday Through Friday starting February 6 through February 17, 2012

PAT Test: Saturday February 18, 2012 at 8:00 am
