



NON-FLORIDA RESIDENT & INTERNATIONAL STUDENT EXPENSE INFORMATION

The following information is provided concerning matriculation fees, tuition and an estimate of living expenses for full-time applicants who are non-Florida residents and from other countries who plan to attend Edison. International students must have sufficient finances to cover all living and educational expenses incurred while at Edison as verified by a certified financial statement. International students must have funds on deposit and withdrawable from a U.S. bank or other source to cover expenses in the U.S. and additional funds must also be available on a continuous basis to assure adequate financing during the student's entire educational stay in the United States. Documentary evidence of means of financial support must be attached to the Certificate of Eligibility (I-20) when applying for the student visa at the U.S. Embassy or Consular Office.

The College does not provide student housing, and students should arrive in the United States at least 3 weeks prior to the first day of classes to allow time for testing, registration and to locate suitable housing. Students should be prepared to pay three months rent in advance at the time housing is located.

Please note tuition, fees, books & supplies are paid 1 semester at a time and before classes begin.
