CLINICAL MEDICAL ASSISTANT ***(With Internship)***

This program provides comprehensive classroom and clinical instruction. Classroom lectures cover theory, anatomy and terminology of the basic human systems. Clinical instruction provides supervised, hands-on training essential to becoming a CMA.

Theory and practical instruction covers 18 weeks. Competency will be measured by written and practical hands-on exams. Lectures will cover the theory, anatomy and terminology pertaining to each system. Practical material will be presented and graded under close instruction and supervision.

We offer classroom instruction (162 hours) plus an internship (160 hours). Eligible* students will be placed locally in medical offices for their internships upon completion of the classroom portion.

*An eligible student is one who has all prerequisites (see below) on file with Edison State College. Full details will be given during the first class session. Eligible students will be placed in internships no later than 90-180 days from the end of the classroom portion.)

Pre-requisites:

- Over 18 years of age.
- High school diploma or an equivalent
- Competency in or completion of a basic computer operations course
- Competency in both basic Math and English.
(A list of practice websites and/or books is available at time of registration.)

Prior to placement in internship, each student must submit:

- A resume
- Proof of a current medical exam that includes history of vaccinations
- Tuberculosis screening
- Undergo a Background Check/Background Check/Drug Screening
- Each participant will be required to show proof of completion of CPR for the healthcare provider.
- Proof of a current physical examination,
