



Moviemaking for Beginners

Beginning students will work one-on-one with a professional movie producer to understand the technical and aesthetic basics of the digital moviemaking process from concept to completion. Students will collaborate as a film crew in the production of one or more final short films.

Course Outline

- Class 1 –DEVELOPMENT: Turning your idea into a shooting script
- Class 2 – PREPRODUCTION: Casting, scheduling, and assigning film crew roles
- Class 3 – PRODUCTION I: Digital video camera and sound basics
- Class 4 – PRODUCTION II: Directing, acting and interviewing for the camera
- Class 5: POST PRODUCTION I: Editing and assembling the 'rough cut' movie
- Class 6 – POSTPRODUCTION II: Creating the fine cut movie and screen your work
