



## *Writing Short Stories*

Do you enjoy reading short stories? Have you considered writing a short story? Writers in this class will learn from published examples while applying short fiction techniques to their own writing including the writing elements necessary for character and conflict development and using viewpoint and sensory detail to engage the reader. Length and structure necessary for different categories of short fiction and suggested markets for each will also be covered, along with an overview of publishers for short stories and tips for cover letters and submission dos and don'ts. Sharing and feedback during every class session is used to strengthen and improve writing. This class is open to both the experienced writer as well as the novice.
