The Dual Enrollment or Early College program offers high school students the opportunity to earn credit towards both a high school diploma and a college degree. Students have the opportunity to take classes at any Edison State College location, their participating public high school or through Edison online. Since 2006, the program has continuously expanded. During the past two years, Edison has established two Collegiate High Schools whose students are also eligible for Dual Enrollment.
