This course consists of 40 hours spread over ten class days. Students will learn about a wide variety of spirits, over 150 drink recipes as well as customer service techniques and stresses alcohol service safety. No Alcohol is used during the course. Students are required to pass a written final exam as well as a practical speed drill to complete the course and graduate.
