NURSING ASSISTANT COURSE

This course is approved by the Florida Board of Nursing in the Florida Department of Health. This course is designed for students to develop patient care skills for employment as nurse assistants in hospitals, clinics and nursing homes. Successful completion of the program prepares the student for the Florida State certification examination and employment as a Certified Nursing Assistant in a nursing home in accordance with Chapter 464, Part II, Florida Statutes. The program length of 120 hours is divided into 80 hours of theory and 40 hours of instructor-supervised clinical practice in the Hendry-Glades area.

Course Requirements

This course requires:

- Reading, workbook assignments
- Participation in classroom and laboratory skill practice
- Satisfactory performance of competency skills in the laboratory
- Mastery of course material
- Satisfactory performance of all scheduled hours of clinical experience

Upon completion of this course, graduates will be eligible to take the Florida State Certification Examination for Nursing Assistants.

Cost of the program: Less than \$1000 including all uniforms, books, tuition, stethoscope, shoes, background check, and health check.
