Dark Room Photography

This course is designed for beginners wishing to learn basic and advanced darkroom techniques. It will focus mainly on Black and White photo processing.

We will start by learning to develop negatives using daylight developing tanks and the technique of tray developing. Students will learn the proper way to wash, dry and store the negatives. We will then move onto the making of contact sheets so we can choose which negative to enlarge. Students will also learn the art of printing using the enlarger to make 8"x10" black & white prints. We will also cover the techniques of burning, dodging and spot retouching.
