



## Digital Moviemaking-Intermediate/Advanced

Students who have completed the Beginning Moviemaking course will continue their film work begun in the introductory course (including reshoots, if needed), and/or completed another, more extensive short film or video of their choice, further utilizing the technical and aesthetic skills learned in the beginning course. Course will focus on advanced editing and lighting techniques and preparing a final product for distribution and film festival entry.
