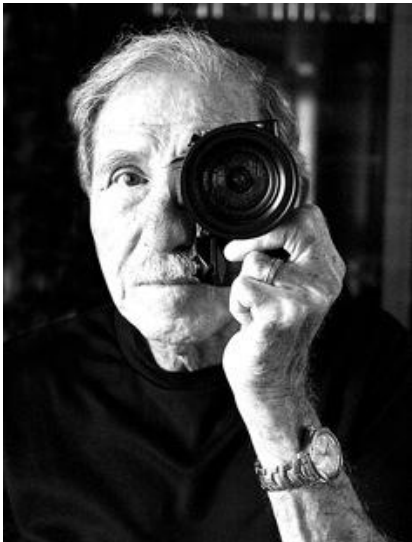

### Digital Photography- THE EYE OF THE PHOTOGRAPHER Part II

The course will begin with a review of the three main component of a good photograph - exposure, lighting, and composition. We will then look at ten reasons that can make a photo bad and ten reasons that make it good. There will be an early morning field trip to explore nature and scenic photography. Student assignments and class critiques will be conducted. The course will end with a slide presentation on specialty photography - Underwater, Marco, Panorama, etc.
