Start a New Career as an Electronic Health Records System Technologist!

Edison State College is offering a new and exciting career as an Electronic Health Records (EHR) System Technologist. By 2014, electronic health records must be in use by Healthcare Providers. Employment of EHRST professionals by physicians and healthcare provider offices, EMR vendors and government organizations is expected to grow 20% by 2018.

To meet this demand and fulfill the federal requirements, professionals must be trained to assist healthcare providers to choose, implement, train and maintain EHR systems.

You will learn the essential components of the EHR and health information exchange essentials; system selection and implementation; project management and fundamentals of change including human factors.

Class Instruction: 216 hours over 18 weeks. This program is offered entirely online, with weekly assignments and a weekly instructor-led virtual class (5:30 PM – 6:30 PM PST/PDT).

Course Fee: \$3600 (prices subject to change) includes workbooks, online course access and certificate of completion.

Pre-requisites: Minimum 18 years of age and high school completion or GED, Proficient in keyboarding, basic understanding of word processing Program (Microsoft Word is recommended), Access to the Internet, printing capabilities & email address.
