Florida State Guardianship 40 hour Training



Would you like to become Florida State Registered Professional?
Congratulations! You are about to embark on a humanitarian effort that will provide you with a large degree of personal satisfaction, while helping others who have some limitation on their ability to manage their lives. You will have the opportunity to meet and overcome a variety of challenges and achieve personal growth. This State approved eight week forty hour training course prepares you to sit the final exam at the end and on passing become registered with the State. It includes the following elements:

1. Types of Guardian, Role of Guardian
2. Role of the courts, Attorneys and Adjudication
3. Guardian of property and Person
4. VA Benefits, SS, Medicare, Medicaid, Insurance
5. Initial and annual reporting
6. Baker Act
7. Abuse, Neglect, end of life decisions
8. Fees, Restoration, Removal, Resignation, course review and Final Test

On passing you become eligible to sit for the Florida Competency Exam which includes the CGC National Certified Guardian Exam. (\$250.) These exams are held 4 times per year in eg: Tampa, Orlando, West Palm Beach, Fort Lauderdale
