“Italian for Beginners”

This course is designed for students with no previous knowledge of Italian. The instructional goal is to develop basic vocabulary and understanding of the structure of the Italian language. The course will begin with the review of the Italian sound system, and continue with basic vocabulary acquisition and grammar. The instruction will focus on developing the four language skills: listening, speaking, reading, and writing.

By the end of the 6 week session the students will be able to name objects around them, count, read and comprehend short texts, engage in brief conversations on everyday topics (family life, weather, ordering a meal at the restaurant, asking for directions, etc).

The goal is to provide the students with the foundation that would enable them to continue learning independently
