



## Movie Editing-Intermediate/Advanced

Students who have completed Movie Editing for Beginners (or those with basic video editing skills in iMovie or Moviemaker, and subject to approval by instructor) will continue their mastery of the artistic and technical elements of movie editing and cinematic storytelling with FINAL CUT PRO 7, and advanced software for MAC.

**Students must have Macintosh laptops with Final Cut 7 software and bring them to class each week.**

**Students may bring in their own footage to cut, but all students will be required to upload footage provided by the instructor for classroom and homework use.**
