Nurse Refresher Program

The Nurse Refresher and Remedial program is an intensive program of didactic (96 hours) and clinical experiences (96 hours) meant to prepare or update nurses who wish to return to the nursing force. This program is also approved by the Florida Board of Nursing for remediation of the nursing graduate who has not been successful with the NCLEX-RN exam. Lectures, home studies, skills lab and acute hospital clinical experiences are provided in a relaxed atmosphere to promote learning.
