# Nurse Remedial Program

The Nurse Remedial program is designed for the Registered Nurse and LPN reentering the work force and the Graduate Nurse in need of remediation. The course will review anatomy, psychology, pathophysiology, pharmacology, the nursing process and current trends in nursing. Emphasis will be placed on the National Patient Safety Goals and how these goals improve the delivery of safe patient care. This course will include a comprehensive review of telemetry and rhythm and analysis and math. Additionally, the course will incorporate competencies based on the nurse refresher and remedial skills checklist used in the clinical portion of the course.

This is an intensive program of didactic (96 hours; 42 hours lecture; 54 hours Home Study) and clinical experiences (96 hours). The course outcome will prepare or update nurses who wish to return to the nursing force. This program is approved by the Florida Board of Nursing (64B9-3.0025) see below for remediation of the nursing graduate who has not been successful with the NCLEX RN exam. Lectures, home studies, skills lab and acute hospital clinical experiences are provided in a relaxed atmosphere to promote learning. NCLEX review will be done during classroom instruction.

*Our curriculum documents clinical experience and theoretical instruction in medical, surgical, obstetric, pediatric, geriatric nursing and psychiatric nursing. The curriculum documents clinical training experience in appropriate settings that include, but are not limited to, acute care, long-term care, and community settings. This program provides theoretical instruction and clinical application in personal, family, and community health concepts; nutrition; human growth and development throughout the life span; body structure and function; interpersonal relationship skills; mental health concepts; pharmacology and administration of medications; and legal aspects of practice. This program also provides theoretical instruction and clinical application in interpersonal relationships and leadership skills; professional role and function; and health teaching and counseling skills.*

**Learning Outcomes:** Upon successful completion of the Nurse Remedial course the participant will have demonstrated through evaluation of their performance the ability to:

1. Identify the National Patient Safety goals and relate each one to clinical practice
2. Discuss the disease processes and how the nurse assessment and critical thinking are related to patient outcomes.
3. Identify current diagnostic and treatment modalities and pharmacologic interventions for pathologic conditions of the body.
4. Identify and discuss the cultural diverse populations of our community and our workforce. Furthermore, identify therapeutic communication skills necessary to deliver culturally-sensitive nursing care
5. Pass the sample NCLEX tests provided during each session.

**METHOD OF INSTRUCTION:** The interactive course includes lecture, class discussion, lab simulations, power point, exercises, tests and home study.
