The Ophthalmology Technician Program provides the student with the opportunity to become a trained technician who will be well placed for positions in the Ophthalmology practices in Lee and surrounding counties.

This course will provide student with a basic understanding of the Ophthalmic profession and the skills required to perform common tasks and procedures in the modern Ophthalmology practice. Furthermore, the certificate program provides the student the foundation to build skill levels and to achieve formal certification through JCAHPO (Joint Commission on Allied Health Personnel in Ophthalmology). The program itself uses the JCAPHO models as its framework for the didactics and clinical education of the student.
