Painting fundamentals: Acrylics/Oils

Acrylics have been a celebrated and forgiving medium. With easy clean up and no toxic odors, acrylics have been an endearing, versatile paint offering a multitude of possibilities and techniques. With low odor solvents contained in small orifices, oil painting can be just as joyous as acrylic painting. Learn the fundamentals of painting, we will learn to mix colors learning value contrasts, intensity contrasts, temperature contrasts, arranging compositions, and experiment with brush manipulations. Painting from observation with simple still life objects will enable one to understand the fundamentals of form and light. With demonstrations, one on one tutoring, learning this medium as we undertake these simple exercises will allow you to gain confidence and appreciate light and form you never knew you could accomplish with a brush.
