This course provides the student with a step by step approach in developing their oil painting skills. The class includes discussion of materials and tools, organizing a palette, using value as the foundation of color and composition, review of basic color theory, perspective, and discussion of the nature of light in the modeling form. Basic drawing concepts are reviewed as fundamental to the painting process. Students will begin with a limited palette early and advance to a more extended palette as the course evolves. Various approaches to painting will be discussed
