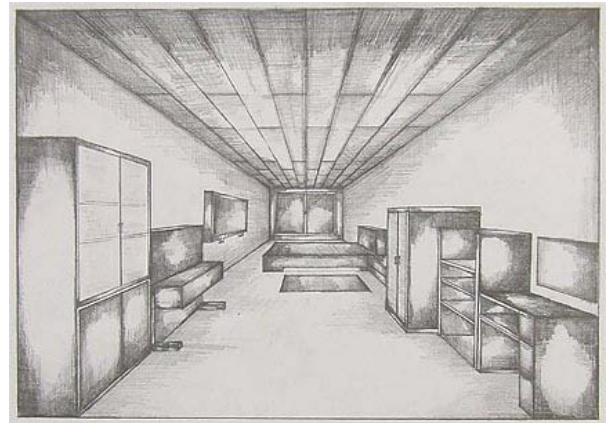

Perspective Made Easy

Learn how to draw an interior or a view with spatial depth. This course is suited for both the interior design student and the fine artist. Understanding the principles of linear perspective is key to drawing from life or the imagination accurately. Students will learn to draw the impression of three-dimensional space, including how to make objects appear to literally sit in space. The tools and methods of linear perspective allow the Interior Design student to create accurate renderings of interiors from the imagination or allow the fine artist to accurately depict the illusion of depth in their drawings or paintings. Acquiring the skills and knowledge of perspective will help students improve independently in their work.
