Sculpting Elegant Figures in 3-D
“From T-shirt to Garden Statue”
Sculpting with Fabric and Paper
“Sitting Figure”



This 2-part workshop is an exercise in the art form of sculpting using textiles and natural fibers. Students will use the next generation of textile hardeners, a new line of products developed due to the demand of better quality hardeners. Class participants will build an armature for a sitting figure. Once the armature is constructed students will drape, mould, detail and paint the sculpture. Experimentation with impregnated color, dry wrap and wet wrap methods will be demonstrated, and applied during the sculpting process. This class is for the hobbyists and fine art student.

Students will:

- Review product uses
- Design, construct, and mold armature
- Experiment with dry wrap and wet wrap methods using natural fibers-textiles
- Drape, paint and detail the sculpture
- Prepare a support base
- Seal finished sculpture
