Stone Art Workshop

This one-day workshop is an exercise in the art form of sculpting using natural fibers, "Stone Art" (a powder) and "Powertex" (a hardener.) Students will use this next generation of textile hardener to sculpt a "home decor" decoration that can proudly be displayed.

Powertex is an environmentally friendly alternative to polyester. You can harden all absorbent materials to include paper, textiles, delicate rice papers, and natural fibers etc...it can be used to make jewelry, create large and small statues, home decorations, and paintings and canvas work. Whether you are a hobbyist, a student of fine art, or an accomplished artist, you'll enjoy working with multi-level textural effects. The strength and versatility of these third generational hardeners is unmatched in the marketplace today.

In class students will build the armature, drape, mould, detail and paint the art piece.

Students will purchase a product kit from the instructor to include the armature and products required to complete the project.
