Stone Setting Workshop

This class addresses fundamental stone setting techniques for faceted as well as cabochon gemstones. We will cover basic skills, prong settings, tube settings, and a hammer set stone. We will demo gypsy set and or flush set stones for those who are interested as well. The proper handling of gemstones during setting will also be discussed. These methods augment jewelry making skills. Practice prong settings, tube settings and CZ's will be provided.

Pre-Requisite: Prior jewelry making experience is required

Pin vise (optional)
Bench pin
Notched prong pusher
Chain nose not smallest or largest size pliers for modifying
Slim line flush cut diagonal cutters
