Materials: Approx. \$85.00 Per Student- Material list supplied at time of registration.

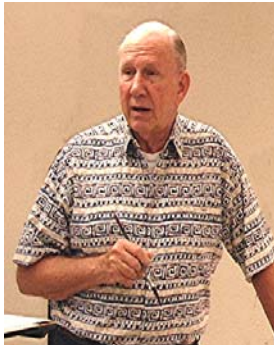
