1. SCOPE OF WORK- THE FLORIDA SOLAR CONTRACTOR MAY INSTALL, ALTER, REPAIR, MAINTAIN, RELOCATE OR REPLACE SOLAR, P.V. SYSTEMS. OVERVIEW OF CLASS / TEST.

2. FLORIDA BUILDING CODES 2007

GENERAL KNOWLEDGE, SPECIFIC CODES IMPACTING P.V./SOLAR LICENSING. NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE NFPA70- AS IT RESTRICTS AND GUIDES SOLAR AND PHOTOVOLTAIC INSTALLATIONS.

3. DOMESTIC SOLAR THERMAL AND HOT WATER SYSTEMS. HOT WATER AND POOL INSTALLATIONS AND REPAIRS.

4. DESIGN & BUILD. HOW TO SUCCESSFULLY ESTIMATE, DESIGN AND BUILD A PV OR SOLAR THERMAL SYSTEMS WITH MAXIMUM SAVINGS AND CODE COMPLIANCE.

5. PRACTICE EXAM. A GUIDED TOUR THROUGH THIS PORTION OF THE EXAM, USING ACTUAL TEST MATERIALS.
