Basic Intra Oral Radiography Certification for Office Trained Auxiliaries

This course is approved for certification for Dental Radiographers (Florida Administrative Code, Chapter 64B5-9.011)

Course Description:

This course offers a combination of theory and hands-on practice for dental auxiliaries to acquaint them with the necessary principles and practices needed for certification as currently required by Florida law.

The first day of class is taught in a lecture/discussion format. The second day provides hands-on clinical experience with mannequins to improve skills in exposing radiographs.
