Drawing fundamentals: Colored Pencil

The color pencil has been a celebrated medium for at least half a century years. Color pencil is coming into its own respect as a medium with as much integrity as any other media.

Learn the fundamentals of color theory, as we learn to mix colors, learn value contrasts, intensity contrasts, temperature contrasts, arranging compositions, and experiment with possible techniques to understand the foundations of making art. As a beginner, working from photos and simple still life arrangements, you will gain tremendous insights into



the endless possibilities techniques can provide for any subject or particular area of your design. With demonstrations, one on one guidance, and class discussions, learning this medium will allow you to gain confidence and appreciate light and form you never knew you could accomplish.

Materials:

1-24 or larger package of Colored Pencils; (Sanford Prismacolor, Faber-Castell Polychromos, Derwent Studio, Koh-i-noor, Lyra, Caran D'Ache) **Do not use Derwent Artist series or Prismacolor Verithins*

1 each; 2B, 4B and one ebony graphite pencils

1- 14 x 17, or 9 x 12 80lb. Canson, Strathmore, or Jack Richeson pad

1 kneaded eraser

1 factis or magic rub eraser

1 pencil Stump or tortillions

1 sanding pad

1 utility knife

1 tackle / tool box

1 workable fixative spray can
1 18" ruler
1 cardboard viewfinder with at least a 2.25 x 3 opening

Alternative paper; Arches, Strathmore, Canson, Bristol Board, Rives BFK, Lenox
