### **Everyday Spanish for Nurses - Intermediate**

This course continues where Everyday Spanish for Nurses left off. Edison State College is now offering a 5 week 15 hour Spanish for Nurses Intermediate class. Learning everyday medical terminology in Spanish can increase productivity and efficiency as well as reduce frustration and lack of communication.

With Spanish for Nursing, you will be able to do the following (and more) in Spanish:

- Obtain basic information and history about the patient
- Perform physical assessment including vital signs
- Prepare patients for surgery or other procedures
- Administer medications and injections
- Feed and bathe patients
- Assist and interact with the patient's family
- Indicate knowledge of Hispanic health system
- Reduce Hispanic's fear of hospital settings
- Honor patient's requests
- Assist in emergency situations

- Perform routine procedures
