Students will learn and participate in the fundamentals of Method Acting as developed and practiced at the Actors Studio in New York and Los Angeles. Participants will focus on developing a “truthful” inner life. Scene Study and Scene Work will also be taught to beginning acting students and to those who have had prior acting experience and who would like to learn the “Method” approach to “Truth” in acting. Audition procedures, cold reading, and differences between Film and Stage acting will also be addressed.
